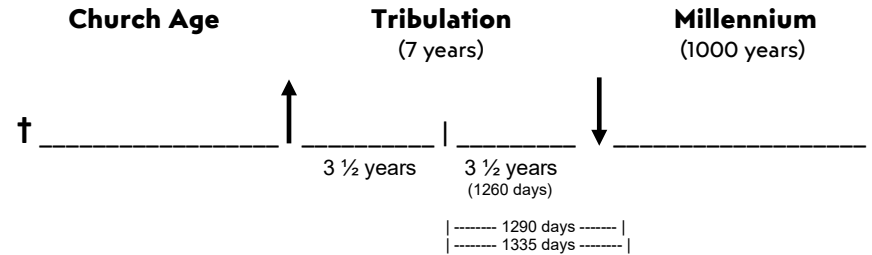

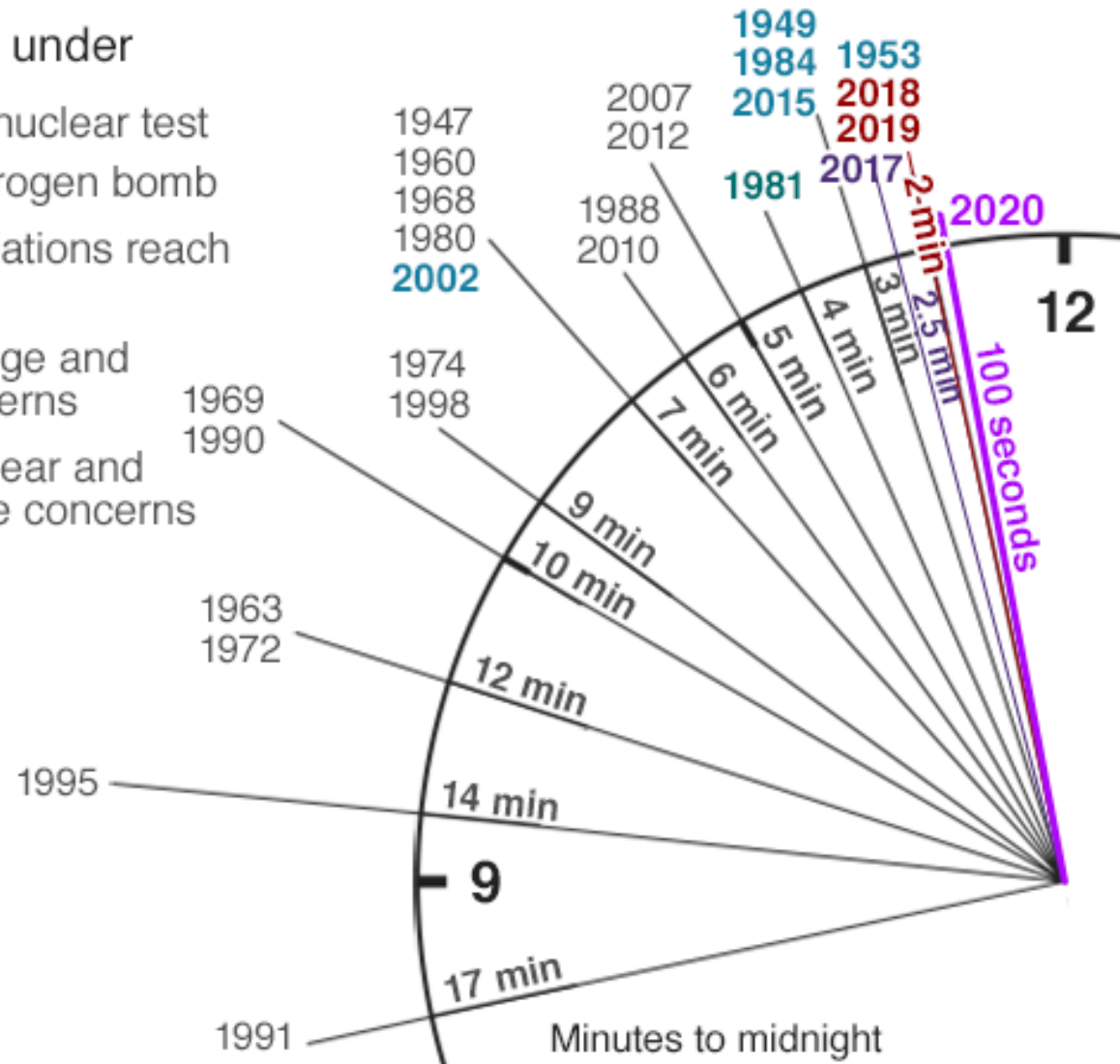
1949: Soviet's first nuclear test
