



Bubble size indicates the number of donors in a category. The horizontal position of each bubble indicates the annual giving per giving unit. The vertical center point indicates the total given by those in that category.

For example, the first bubble is large with 153 giving units. The horizontal position means those donors each gave from \$0 to \$1,000 in the year. The vertical position indicates that these donors collectively gave a total of \$45,916.
